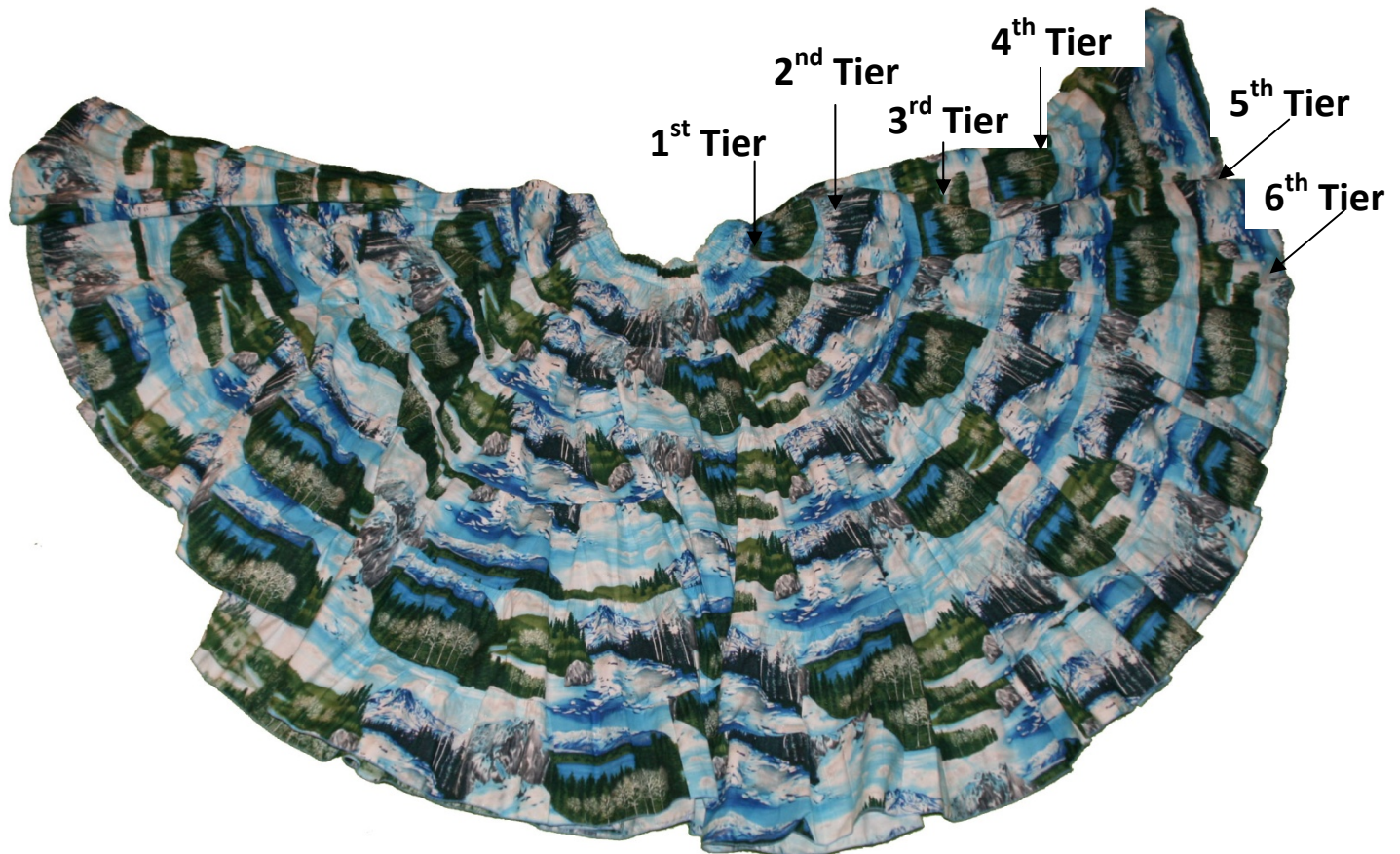


2011 USAWest – Longview

Cascade Promenade Prairie Skirt - 6 Tiers



The top tier has a 1 ½" fold over for elastic and a serged edge and is cut to 9" wide, dropping the seam for the 1st & 2nd tiers below the hip. The Mountain Design repeats every 12" so the remaining tiers are cut 6" wide. Each tier is attached to the one above with a ½ " seam allowance so finished tiers are 5" wide. The bottom tier is serged with a wooly overlock thread and silver overlock thread fed through the upper looper together. (If you bought the kit, you will need to purchase an additional 2 yards of fabric at \$6.99/yard for the 6 tier skirt).

Tier 1 is 60" long. It requires 1 ½ strips of 9" x 45" fabric (1/2 yard of fabric)

Tier 2 is 1 ½ times longer than tier 1 or 90" long. It requires 2 strips of 6" x 45" fabric (1/3 yards)

Tier 3 is 1 ½ times longer than tier 2 or 135" long. It requires 3 strips of 6" x 45" fabric (1/2 yards)

Tier 4 is 1 ½ times longer than tier 3 or 202.5" long. It requires 4 ½ strips of 6" x 45" fabric (1 yard)

Tier 5 is 1 ½ times longer than tier 4 or 303.75" long. It requires 6.75 strips of 6" x 45" wide fabric (1.17 yards)

Tier six (6) is 1 ½ times longer than tier 5 or 455.63" long and requires 10.13 strips of 45" wide fabric (1.83 yards)

6 Tiers will make a skirt that is 32 ½ " long Minor length adjustments are made to the 1st tier.

For skirts that are less than 30" long, remove the 6th tier.
